We are proud of the continued high standards achieved by our pupils which remain above national figures.

As you can see from this table Little Aston Primary Academy performance ranks in the top 2% nationally for the proportion of pupils meeting the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics combined, the higher standard in English grammar, punctuation and spelling as well as in reading and mathematics overall.

The % achieving the expected standard in writing is in the top 4% and the top 3% for English grammar, punctuation and spelling nationally.
